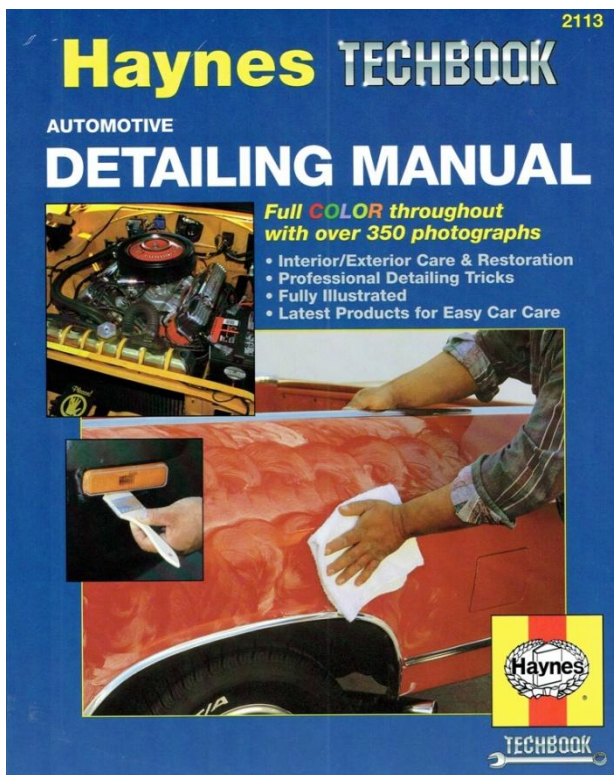


Book Reviews
